



## **INVITATION FOR PROSPECTIVE SUPPLIERS AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDERS TO REGISTER ON THE CWP- GREEN DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION DATABASE**

The Community Work Programme(CWP) is a government programme, based in the Department of Coorporative Governance. The primary purpose of the programme is to create an employment safety net organised around Municipalities (Sites). Each site employs 1,000 or more unemployed participants and managed by Implementing Agents (IA).

Green Development Foundation (GDF) was appointed by the Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs to implement the CWP in the Free State Province. Amongst its responsibilities as an implementing agent, is the procurement of goods and services. It is for this reason that, GDF invites interested service providers and suppliers to register on its CWP database for the following;

- Supply of Personal Protective Equipment.
- Supply of Tools and Materials.
- Professional Training providers
- Professional consulting services in the field of;
  - Agriculture/Construction etc.
  - IT Support
  - Legal/Marketing etc.

Service Providers are allowed to register only three (3) categories at a time. Services will be highlighted in the online database registration form. Please note that GDF will not conduct any business with suppliers who are not registered on the Central Supplier Database.
